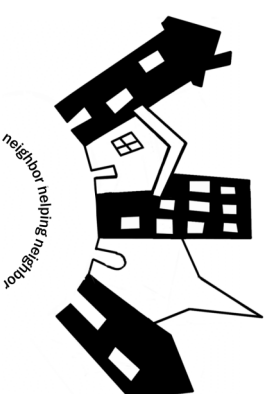

## **ALCOHOL AND OTHER DRUG ABUSE:**

Addiction is characterized by significant impairment in the emotional, psycho-logical, spiritual, physical, and social areas that are directly associated with the persistent and excessive use of substances. Impairment may involve psychological or social dysfunction.

## **DEREK HOUSE:**

Manna, Inc., the parent organization of Derek House, was established in 1991 as a faith-based non-profit agency dedicated to providing services to people who are hurting, hungry and destitute.

Derek House arose from this dedication to provide professional substance abuse assessment, diagnosis, and treatment to adults regardless of race, ethnicity, sex, religion, political affiliation, marital status, physical, sexual orientation or their financial position.

The primary mission of Derek House is to care for people by providing community based substance abuse treatment programs that foster independence. Reflecting the caring nature of our mission, Derek House is committed to providing quality service that promotes dignity and a positive environment for adults with chemical dependency problems and to advocate for their mental, physical, and spiritual well being.

## **RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT PROGRAM:**

Derek House is an extended care facility which provides a structured treatment environment for clients who have either completed a detoxification program or who need a higher level of support to enable them to remain sober for a period before moving back into the community or continued treatment.

Derek House provides individualized treatment programs to meet the needs of each client. Treatment lasts from a minimum of six months up to 12 months.

Derek House provides 24 hour, 7 day coverage by on-site, trained staff.

## **SERVICES INCLUDE:**

- Individual, family, and group substance abuse counseling
- Christian-based counseling
- Educational and vocational counseling
- Specialized treatment and psychiatric consultation for clients with co-occurring mental disorders
- Referrals to support service(s) as needed
- Daily living skills training

## **CLIENTS IN THE RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT PROGRAMS MUST BE:**

- Eighteen years of age or older
- Free of all mood-altering substances on the day of admission
- Physically and mentally able to participate in a therapeutic community environment
- Motivated for treatment

## **FEES:**

Derek House accepts MaineCare and private medical insurance.
